IV. NAME/DESCRIPTION OF FOOD ITEMS TO BE SOLD (Reasonable Prices & Food Pack to the value of \$10):

V. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. Completed application form with the prescribed payment must be posted or paid bank to bank or in person.
2. The selection of stall location will be based on date of payment on **FIRST PAYMENT AND FIRST SERVED BASIS**.
3. Applicants must attach to their application form the following:
 - a. Food Safety Supervisor Certificate and;
 - b. Current Public Liability Insurance.
4. Stallholders must maintain cleanliness at all times – during and after the event (**penalties will apply**)
5. Stallholders must only display and sell fresh quality food products at reasonable prices. In previous years the customers have complained that their foods are overpriced.
6. Stallholders are not allowed to consume or sell alcohol, beer and spirit during the event which is strictly alcohol-free event (**penalties will apply**).
7. Stallholders' owned business-related fliers, brochures and promo materials are allowed to be distributed during the event; provided they are of high quality/standard and sample/s have been attached to this registration form.
8. Stallholders must attend the Stall Selection Meeting and Final Briefing that will be scheduled prior to the event. Failure to attend these meetings may result in cancellation of application or given less priority in next year's event.
9. Stallholders must respect the rights of other stallholders on such matters as safety, noise, cleanliness, and space occupancy, among others.
10. Stallholders will not display, demonstrate or sell to the public any dangerous and prohibited goods.

11. Stall applicants who are authorized to sell Fiesta-Kultura raffle tickets, or solicit advertisements for the souvenir program, **must remit payment no later than the Final Stallholders Meeting or 10 days before the event.** No Advert will be printed if not paid.
12. In the event of cancellation, only partial refund of stall rental fee will be allowed to cover administrative costs, thus: less 10% if made 30 days or more prior to the event; less 20% if made 20 days to 29 days prior to the event; less 30% if made 10 days to 19 days prior to the event; and less 40% if made less than 10 days before the event.
13. Stallholders have equal chances to win Stall Incentive Awards that may consist thus: **Best Presented Stall, Best Creative and Innovative Stall, and Best Authentic Philippine Motif & Native Costume.**
14. The stall trading hours during the event shall be from 9am to 7pm and clean-up time shall be from 7pm to 10pm. Vehicles will be allowed inside the fiesta premises from 9pm or at the close of the stage program (beauty pageant), whichever comes first **with the Security Director/Marshal clearance.**
15. The PASC, Inc. reserves the right to refuse any application for whatever reason it deems necessary.

VI. FAIRFIELD CITY COUNCIL HEALTH REGULATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR FOOD STALLHOLDERS:

- a. Food stallholders must strictly adhere to NSW Food Authority and Local Council Health Food Regulations and requirements, specifically those detailed in their brochure regarding: Cooking Equipment / Food Preparation / Eating Utensils / Food Storage / Food Display / Fire Safety Equipment / Transportation of Food / Food Temperature Control / Washing Facilities / Food Handling Practices / Waste Storage / Disposal.
- b. As alternative to electric power supply, stallholders must provide their own gas cooking equipment. Each food stall is allocated total **10-amp power supply**. If appliances usage goes beyond, the power will cut off. **Electrician service call will be charge to Stall holder.** Those with **15amp warming equipments**, e.g. Bay Marie, Food Warmers, etc. MUST let us know so we can provide.
- c. All food must be cooked on Fiesta Day and must be neatly packed in clean plastic containers in accordance with prescribed Health Regulations.
- d. For smoke prevention and safety, cooking must be done inside the designated food preparation area in the stall and no selling activities and presence of customers are allowed in the cooking area.
- e. Only food warming facilities and selling activities are allowed in the stall selling area.
- f. No cooking will take place in the public passageway.
- g. Stallholders must bring their own tested industrial heavy duty extension lead which shall **not be more than 25 meters in length.**
- h. All food handlers and chefs must wear protective hand gloves and head gears.
- i. All inflammable materials must be stored safely and securely.
- j. Non-compliance of Council Health Regulations could result in the stall being shut down by Council Inspectors and defiant stallholders could be penalized and prosecuted.
